### Downloading of .pem file

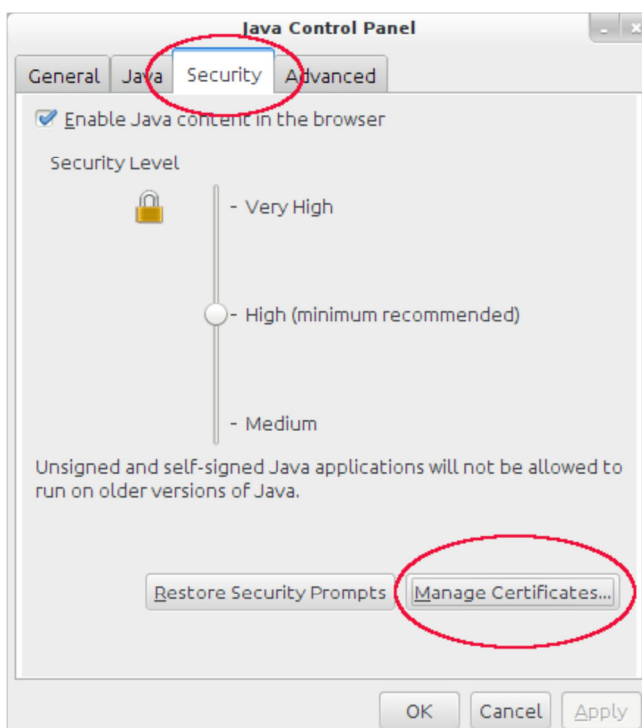
In order to log into the AIM-SG system, you will need to download the .pem file from AIM-SG homepage (Under User Guide). To do, please follow the steps below.

- 1) Right click on the link “.pem file” and choose "Save Target As"/"Save Link As"
- 2) Choose the directory to save the file.
- 3) Make sure the filename is CAASingaporeRoot.pem. If not, type it out exactly.
- 4) Change the "Save as Type" to "All Files".
- 5) Click "Save".

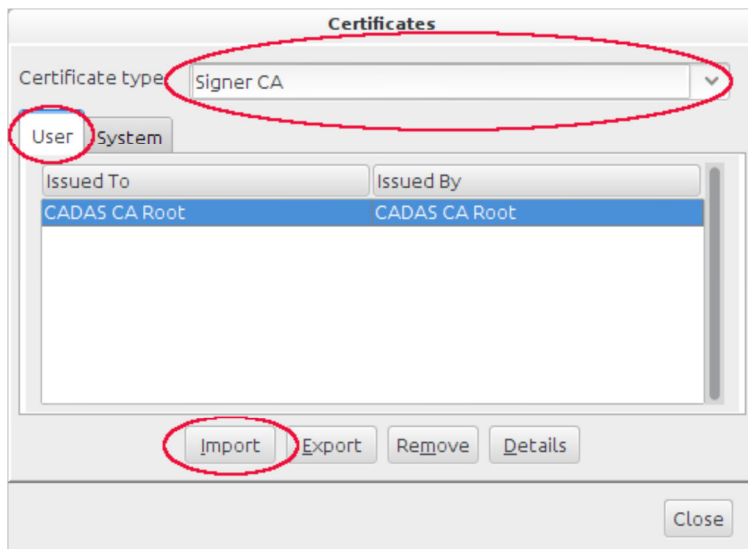
### Linking to .pem file under Java

In order to verify the terminal application JavaWS has to check the signature of the downloaded Jar files. Here a description on how to include the root certificate into JavaWS that is used by COMSOFT:

- 1) First start the javaws application. This is done on unix systems with the command “javaws-viewer” and by starting “Java” in the “Control Panel” when the Windows operating system is used.
- 2) Select the “Security” tab and press “Manage Certificates”.



- 3) In the opened dialog select the certificate type “Signer CA” and select the tab “User”. Press “Import” and select the provided root certificate .pem file. After the certificate has been imported the dialog looks like this:



- 4) The certificates dialog and java control panel can be closed.
